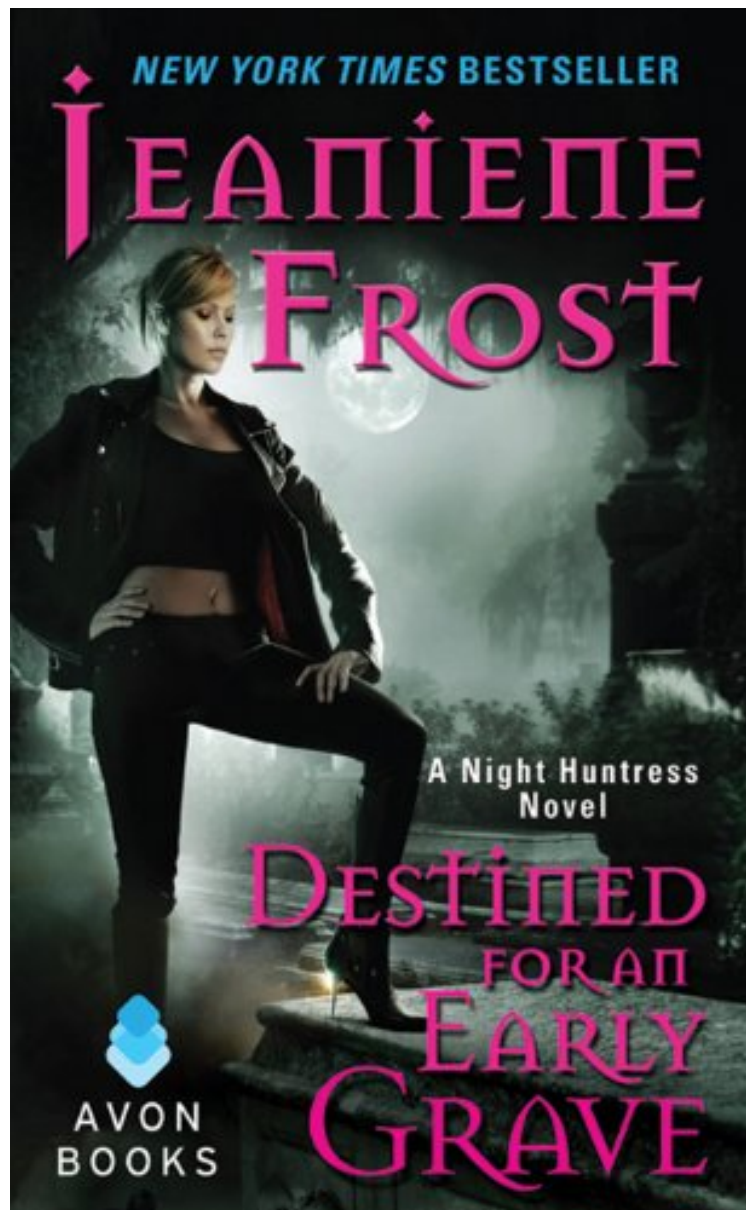

Buch "Destined for an early grave" hat mich muss ich sagen doch schon fast wieder versöhnlich gestimmt! Zwar reicht es bei weitem nicht an "Halfway to the Grave" heran, aber es ist zumindest besser als der 3. Teil "At grave's end", zugegeben, nicht sehr schwierig das zu bertreffen.Ein ehemaliger Liebhaber von Cat taucht auf und behauptet in der Vampirwelt, dass er der legitime Ehemann (nach Vampirrecht) von Cat sei. Ehebruch ist nach Vampirrecht eine ernste Sache, außerdem frdert dies nicht gerade die ohnehin schon kriselnde Liebesbeziehung zwischen Cat und Bones. Cat, deren Erinnerung durch Mencheres ausgelöscht wurde, kann sich an diese Episode ihres Lebens nur dann erinnern, wenn sie sich freiwillig in die Hnde ihres vermeintlich ersten Ehe-Vampirs begibt, was sie auch tut und somit einen Vertrauensbruch zu Bones provoziert.Als die Handlung ist zugegeben ziemlich an den Haaren herbei konstruiert - gerade weil sie Bezug zu Cats Vergangenheit hat und bisher von allen Beteiligten so unter den Teppich gekehrt wurde. Man merkt einfach, dass Jeaniene Frost als sie mit der Serie startete nicht den Gesamt-Verlauf bereits im Kopf hatte, sondern die Romane jeweils Einzel-Geschichten sind, die halt mit den gleichen Charakteren besetzt wurden. Dies erspart einem Autor dann auch die Arbeit jedesmal neue Figuren zu erfinden. Leider leidet darunter die Qualitt der Serie so ziemlich. Die Figuren verhalten sich nicht immer konsequent, verndern sich teilweise sogar sehr stark. Schade, Halfway to the Grave war ein echt guter Wurf. Er verleitete wohl eine Serie darauf aufzubauen, was aus meiner Sicht ziemlich in die Hose gegangen ist. Im Roman "First drop of Crimson" werden dann Nebenfiguren in den Vordergrund geschoben und ich denke, das liegt dem Schreibstil von Jeaniene Frost eher, da dies dann in sich abgeschlossene Romane sind.A propos Schreibstil. Wie schon bei "At Graves End" hat Jeaniene Frost es nicht geschafft mich mittels des Spannungsbogens bis zum Ende an das Buch zu fesseln. Spannung ist zu spren, aber der Spannungshhepunkt kommt entweder zu frh oder geht so verloren, dass ich die letzten Seiten erneut ungeduldig berblttert habe. But soon enough new trouble is showing up on the horizon. Cat is having dreams of a powerful (what else?) vampire named Gregor, the dreamsnatcher. He claims to be her rightful husband and that she was unwillingly ripped from his arms 12 years ago. Mencheres then deleted these memories from Cats mind, which can now only be restored by Gregor himself.While trying to make up her mind about whether she wants to have back those memories or not, Bones threatens to start a war over Cat. Under the immense pressure, their relationship and absolute belief in each other starts to crumble. Cat fears to give away details of her whereabouts in her dreams and thus needs to be kept out of all plans and drugged heavily in order not to meet Gregor any more in her sleep.At the same time, the supernatural world grows ever more uncertain of Cats plans to change into a ghul or a vampire. People will have to make choices and choose a side.I truly adore Cat and Bones. Yet, this book didnt quite do it for me as the first two did. I admire J. Frost for daring to accompany a couple on their path together because this is a hard thing to do without boring the reader. Relationships are never easy, they consist of misunderstandings, jealousy, quarrels and lots of hard work. Frost shows us how Cat and Bones try to overcome all of those obstacles. One could almost argue that the rest of the plot is marginal. The novel is suspense-packed, yet still focuses on Cat and Bones.At times, I was overcome with frustration and just wanted to yell at somebody, preferably one of the protagonists. But with strong emotions involved, the actions are very authentic the way they are. Some aspects of the plot were quite predictable (e.g. considering Cats abilities) yet nevertheless exciting to read. Throughout the story, Cat is considerably growing as a character, which really was about time. Her rash decisions and imprudent actions have often been hard to bear. I love Frosts style. Normally, Im not that much into fighting or battle scenes, but in this series they are nerve-wrecking.I also appreciate the development of the other characters such as Vlad, who I just adore. Hes not the ordinary, beautiful vampire but a man with rough edges. I cant wait to read more about him in Frosts new series.Even though I really enjoyed the book, it just wasnt as perfect as the ones before. It was missing a lot of the typical humour. I was also a bit disappointed about Gregors true reasons for pursuing Cat. This made it rather a pseudo-plotline.Still, this book is worth 4 out of 5 stars and I will definitely read everything else that Jeanine Frost is writing. The speaker of this audiobook, Tavia Gilbert, is one of the best English readers I have ever encountered and I do hear quite a lot. It's definitely worth a try!!
