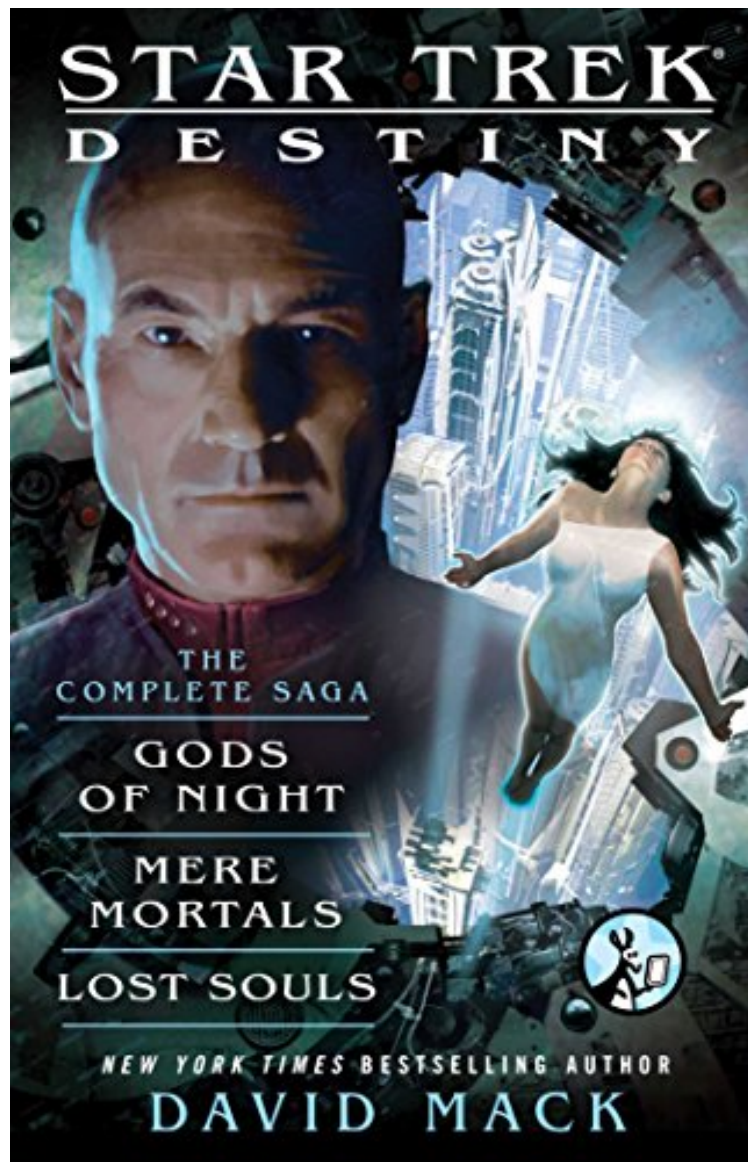

 I always was a fan of the next generation universe but felt the movies never managed to widen the scope, they basically felt like longer episodes of TNG. Now that the reboot is out and nothing of what I loved about Star Trek remains on the big screen I tried my luck at the Destiny Trilogy. I did not have high expectations although I knew the Borg would appear. Boy, was I mistaken. Mack really steps up the game here. This is way beyond the limitations of any of the tv shows or the movies. You get them all in one consistent mix: Picard and his Enterprise (with XO Worf), Riker and his newly introduced Titan - very promising, a reborn Dax with her prototype Aventine, and even a bit of Voyager. But that is not what makes up the scale: it is the epicness of the Borg war, the scale of it, Mack dares to kill off countless entire worlds. Throw in a little bit of surprisingly consistent time-travel and you get three books you would like to finish in one evening.

 This book had some interesting aspects like the Caeliar civilization, but there were more things that got on my nerves than pistive aspects: I don't like books with lots of action scenes because I normally find them boring and tedious - the ones here were no exception. Especially the Hirogen action seemd utterly pointless. There was very little character development. The conflict between Will and Deanna was painted in very dark colours and especially Deanna acted very unprofessionally and like a distraught teenager instead of a rather mature adult.. However, as soon as the immediate problem was solved - everything was perfect. Picard is shown in very pessimistic moods, willing to risk genocide and again - as soon as the immediate problem is solved - he is a happy man and back to his normal self. Both solutions feel very superficial and unconvincing. Both personal conflicts are repeated again and again - and really just repeated without evolution. The fact that close peronal relations between different levels of the same hierarchy may cause problems is alluded to - but I am surprised that an organization like Starfleet does not have rules against such obvious conflicts of interest. The story might have been better if shortened by 20%-30%.
