Bashir is still the eager inexperienced young man, who wants to practice "true frontier medicine", Kira's still the tough, nearly out of control ex, but not really ex, guerilla. The characterisation is not flawed in this book. But the characters have evolved so much in the 7 years that it's almost incredible to read about the beginning. And because almost half of the book deals with the psychological processes of these two and between these two, it's not among the best of ST DS9 books I've read (That's Fallen Heroes,, of course). Besides this, the second plot line deals with a nest of horta babies crawling through the station, being unresponsive to communication or to phaser fire. Of course the crisis rises as they crawl on, destroying this or that vital part of the station. Boredom rises as well, for nothing really happens besides more destruction and more desparation.
