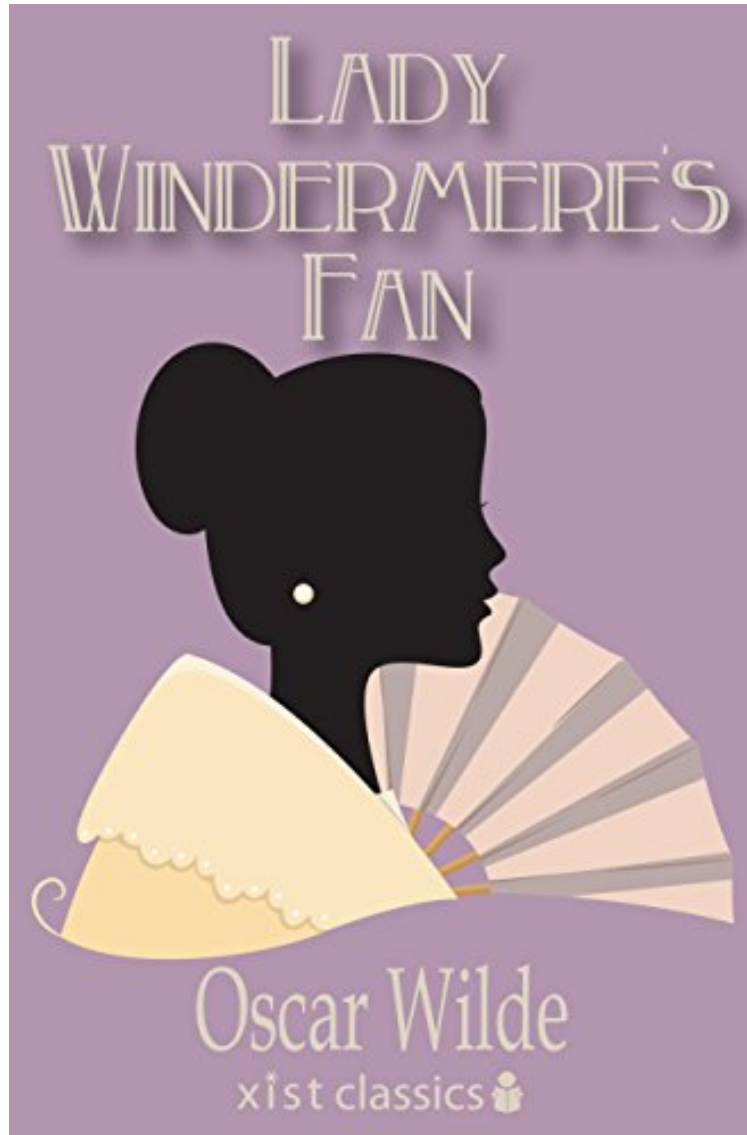

Von Vic87Wow, I'm really happy right now that reminded me of evaluating this book. The first thing that has to be said is that it doesn't get funnier than Oscar Wilde. I really love all of his books, and "Lady Windermere's Fan" ranks very highly in my all-time favourite list. It simply comprises everything I like the most about Wilde's style: it's funny, quirky, intriguing, fast-paced. This four-act comedy is about a woman called Lady Windermere who discovers that her husband is having an affair with another woman called Mrs Erlynne. Upon this she starts having an affair with Lord Darlington. What strikes me most is the effortless use of words that characterises the title. "Fan" has an ambiguous meaning, referring on the one hand to the fan Lady Windermere's husband gives her, and on the other hand it refers to Lord Darlington, Lady Windermere's biggest fan. I just really love this book, it is one of my all-time favourites, and it's always a pleasure to re-read it. Being to think you can easily finish it within a couple of hours, but I would rather advise to read it carefully and thoroughly and I promise you, you will enjoy it!
