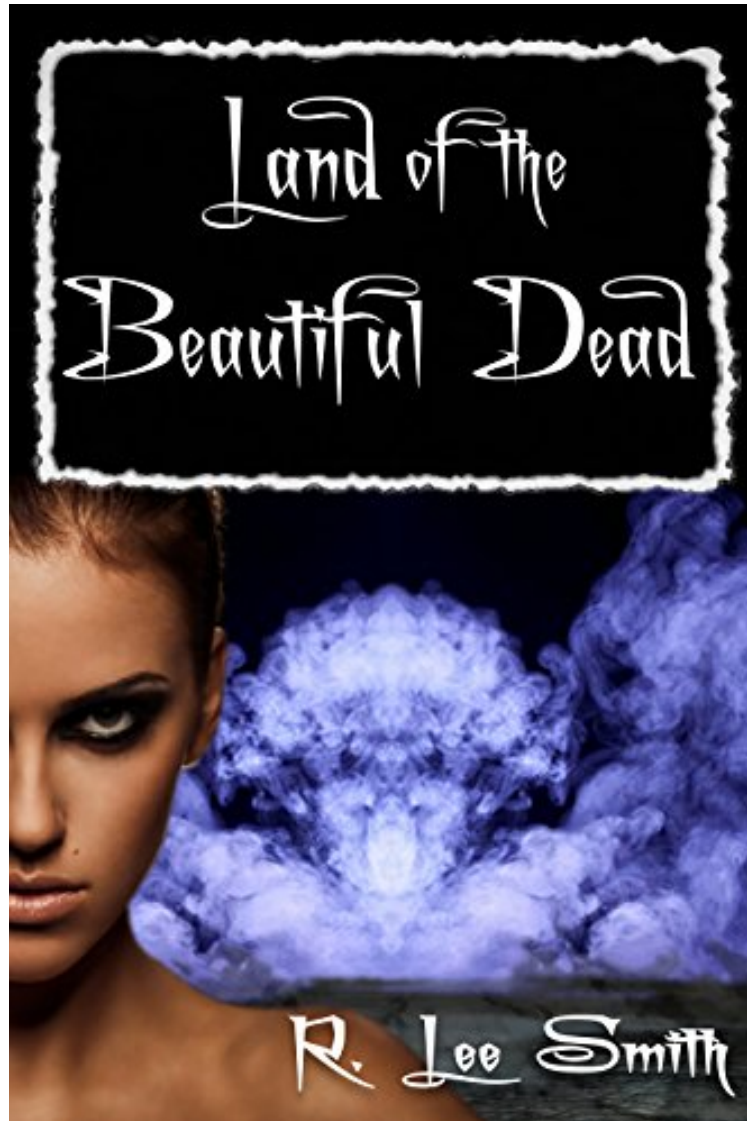

And I can tell you why.Because "Land Of The Living Dead" by R. Lee Smith is hands down the best thing you have read in a long, long time.This book has consumed me pretty much 24/7. Even when I wasn't reading, I was thinking about it. And at night, it happened that I dreamt about it.There is no way to put a label on the story. It's dystopian, erotic, romantic, but most of all, it is one of the most beautiful and touching love stories ever written.The world R. Lee Smith created is elaborate and detailed, but unlike many other books, the details don't bore or drag on. Instead, they helped me get lost in a world that was equally scary and hopeless as it was fascinating and luring.The premise is truly unique and might appear like it's something out of the comfort zone for some people. But all I can say is to give this book a chance.In a world ruled by the dead or actually undead, their leader Azrael is feared as a ruthless, brutal monster. And one that can't be destroyed as he's immortal. The living barely manage to exist, not only fighting against starvation and illness, but also living in constant fear of the Eaters - brainless zombies trying to get a bite. The same Eaters that are Azrael's army against humans - their numbers growing with every occurring death.In the middle of this desolate, hopeless chaos is Lan, a young woman who's been hardened by the desperate situation. After a haunting loss, she makes her way to Azrael's city, ready to convince him to end the Eaters or die trying.But to even have a chance, she has to offer her body to the man the whole world considers awful, revolting and loathsome.And for the first time in his existence, Azrael is confronted with someone who ignites his interest, who isn't too scared to make demands and stand up to him.What follows is passion, madness, heartache, pain, loss and despair, but also something neither Lan nor Azrael have expected.I'm so glad I heard about this book, because it really touched my heart. There were moments with so much angst, that I was scared to read on and find out what happens next and at the same time I couldn't wait to figure out what fate had in store for the characters.I haven't felt such an emotional investment in a story and characters in quite a while. But it was impossible not to get captivated, as Azrael and Lan were characters full of intensity and depth. Their personalities were so well-developed they were tangible and the side-characters weren't that far behind.Lan was pure awesomeness. She was a strong, opinionated, brash heroine who didn't know when it was time to shut up. Diplomacy was definitely not one of her strong points and I loved her for that even more. She was willing to take risks, not as much for her own benefit as for the benefit of others.
