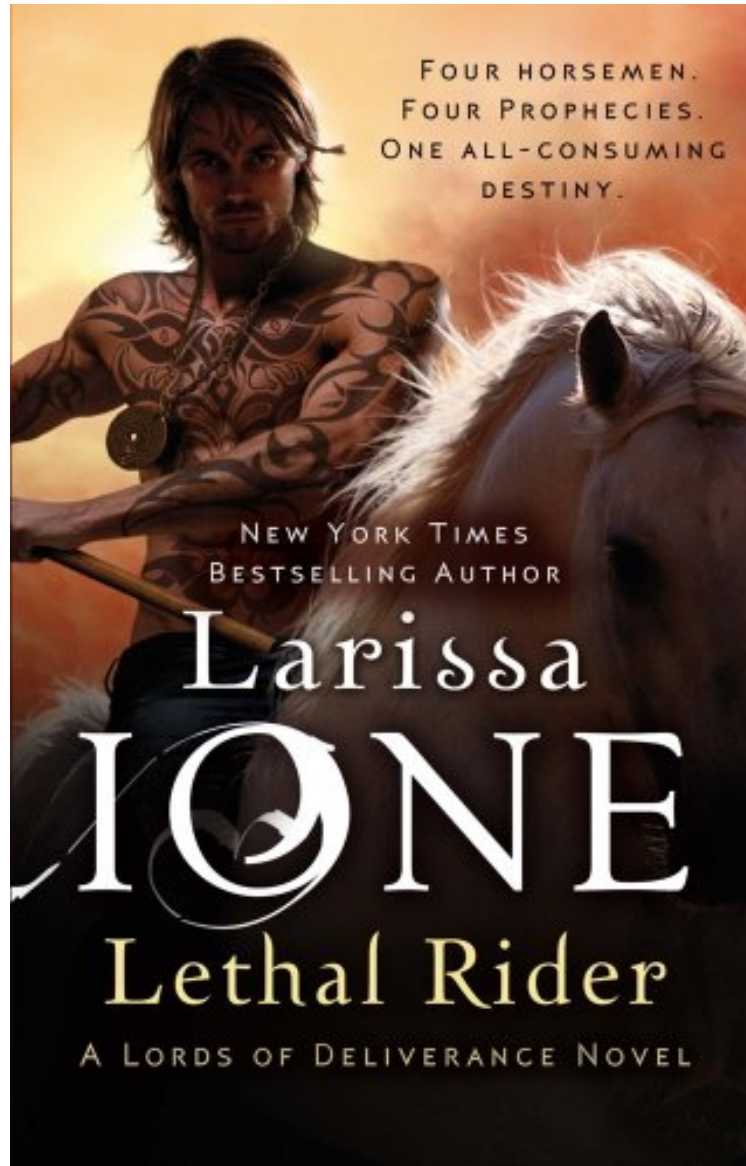

Thanatos is livid and out for revenge. The Aegis Guardian who betrayed him must pay. For the life or death of him; he doesn't understand why Regan gets under his skin. With Pestilence roaming the earth, spreading disease and misery, Than and Regan have no other option than to form a united front. Let me start by saying how much I enjoyed the first two books in the Lords of Deliverance series. Ione is a genius! The world she created sucked me right in. Lethal Rider was a solid follow-up, a great addition, but somehow didn't rock my socks off the way the others did. I had a fun time reading it (I loved the raw emotions and violence); yet it was just more of the same. Especially with such a tight-knit plotline throughout all three books, each has to have its very own special appeal. I know it sounds worse than it actually was. I have nothing to complain about other than that missing certain something. Where was the X factor? And I don't necessarily mean a surprising plot twist. That's not what the X factor is about. It's just so hard to pinpoint a specific aspect. Unfortunately, a certain something is exactly what I need to rate a novel five or even four stars. Enough criticism! On to the praise! Read them in order, for I guarantee you'll want to experience the as-a-whole-greatness. The author did a fantastic job keeping the other characters around and in the thick of things. It's a joined effort to overcome the obstacles; to face the unknown future. You should make good use of the provided glossary. It helped me to remember the details of this complex world. As for the characters, Regal was a kick-ass heroine. On one hand, she had a lot of experience as a demon-slayer. On the other, she had to admit to herself how colossally wrong (even if noble) her decision to seduce Thanatos was. A baby on the way; Regan completely out of her element, miles and miles away from her comfort zone. It sure made it interesting! It's not healthy to blindly trust and depend on someone who hasn't yet proven to be reliable and trustworthy, and Regan realized that along the way. A tough lesson to learn, but in the end, it made her stronger. I had to laugh at her little problem: obsessive-compulsive behavior (it was a fun contrast to her usual composed self). Lots of cursing; that kind of makes it hard to add favorite quotes to my review. 'No-foul-language filter!' **** it, I love foul language. Ione is not afraid to go there. Where? Oh, you just wait for it. Are you squeamish or easily appalled? Then better stay away from this one, because the author's writing is fan-fantastic. The words spill from brain to paper. A beautiful mind! For example: Hades **** off at Pestilence for sticking his nose where it didn't belong. That's just rude! *shakes head*. The writing is also very thought-driven, spoken language on paper if you will. But there's glue (depth to the story) as well, holding it firmly together. Thanatos was one ill-tempered ****. With a heart of gold, that is. He even had a touch of innocence in him. 'From virgin to dad in zero to sixty.' Very attractive! Their baby was the reason they pulled it together. Together being the operative word. The development of Than's and Regan's relationship wasn't rushed, and thank goodness for that. It took both of them some time to realize they were ready to take a chance and voice what they wished for in life, despite the impending apocalypse. I found the sexy schmexy to be sizzling. However, be aware of Regan's nine months pregnant. Pregnancy sex warning! A pulse pounding ride awaits you. Ione knows how to lure readers into her story. Multilayered world building and character's you don't want to leave to their own devices just yet. The lack of a little special 'thrill' bothered me, but I'm sure not all of you will feel this way.
