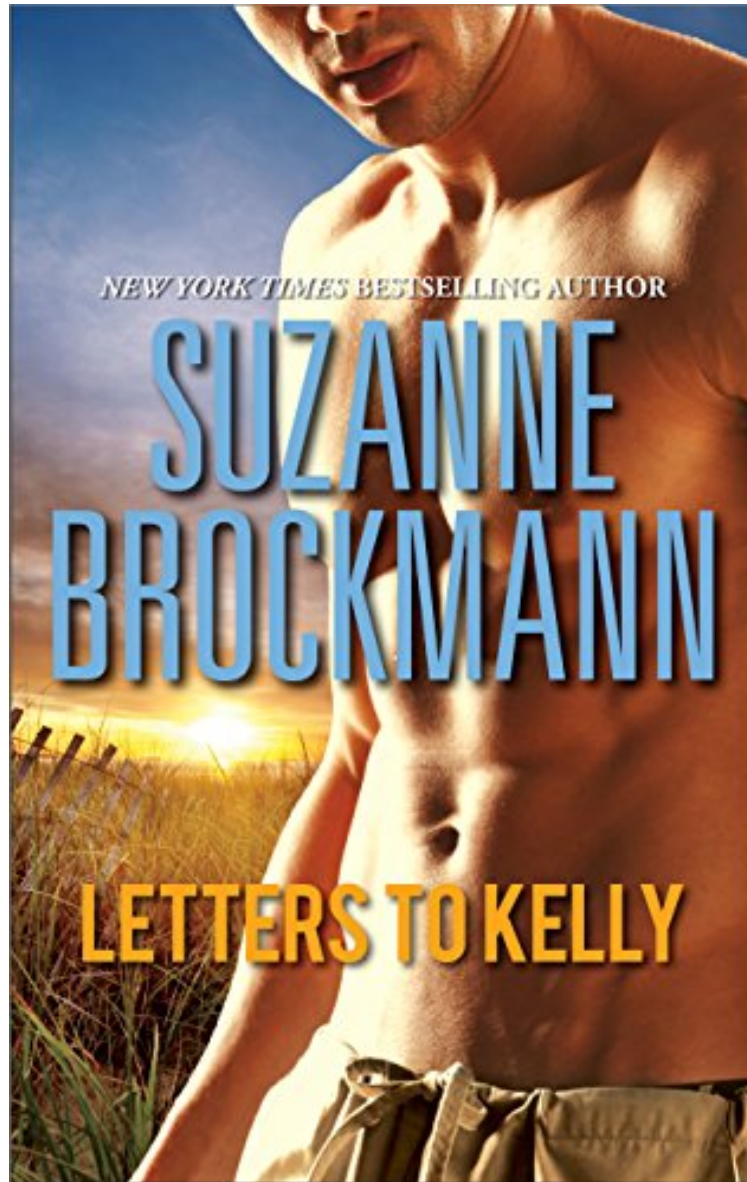

Aber auch hier enttäuscht sie die Leser nicht. Zunächst war es eine Jugendliebe: Kelly ist total in Jax, den besten Freund ihres grossen Bruders verliebt. Er begleitet sie sogar zu ihrem Abschlussball. Allerdings ist er für Kelly zu diesem Zeitpunkt viel zu alt und die Beziehung der beiden wird von unseren Umständen verhindert. Aber das ist nur der Hintergrund für die Geschichte, die Jahre später beginnt. Kelly ist an der Uni und hat schon mehrere Romane veröffentlicht. Nun brennt sie darauf, ihre Lieblingsautorin, die ihre grosse Vorbild ist, kennenzulernen. Was sie nicht weiss ist, dass sich unter dem Pseudonym ihre grosse Liebe Jax verbirgt. Dieser ist nach Jahren wieder in der Stadt und hat sich vorgenommen, sich dieses Mal durch nichts von seinem Ziel, mit Kelly glücklich zu werden, abbringen zu lassen. I have read a few of Suzanne Brockmann's books. Just a few of the Seal ones, which were fabulous. This is a little different. More romantic, soft, sweet. Jax fell in love with sixteen year old Kelly, but he was chased away by her brother who thought he had raped, or would rape her. He became a political prisoner, and spent seven years in jail for something he didn't do. The only thing that helped him to survive was his love for Kelly. He wrote her letters, that he never sent. On returning, he looks her up again. In the meantime, Kelly had married, divorced and was writing a book. The rest of the story is a sweet tale of how Jax wins her back, altho' he has a secret too, a secret that brings them together and keeps them together as the love grows again between them. I enjoyed this story, it was a quick and satisfying read. Suzanne's fans should not be disappointed, it's just different!
