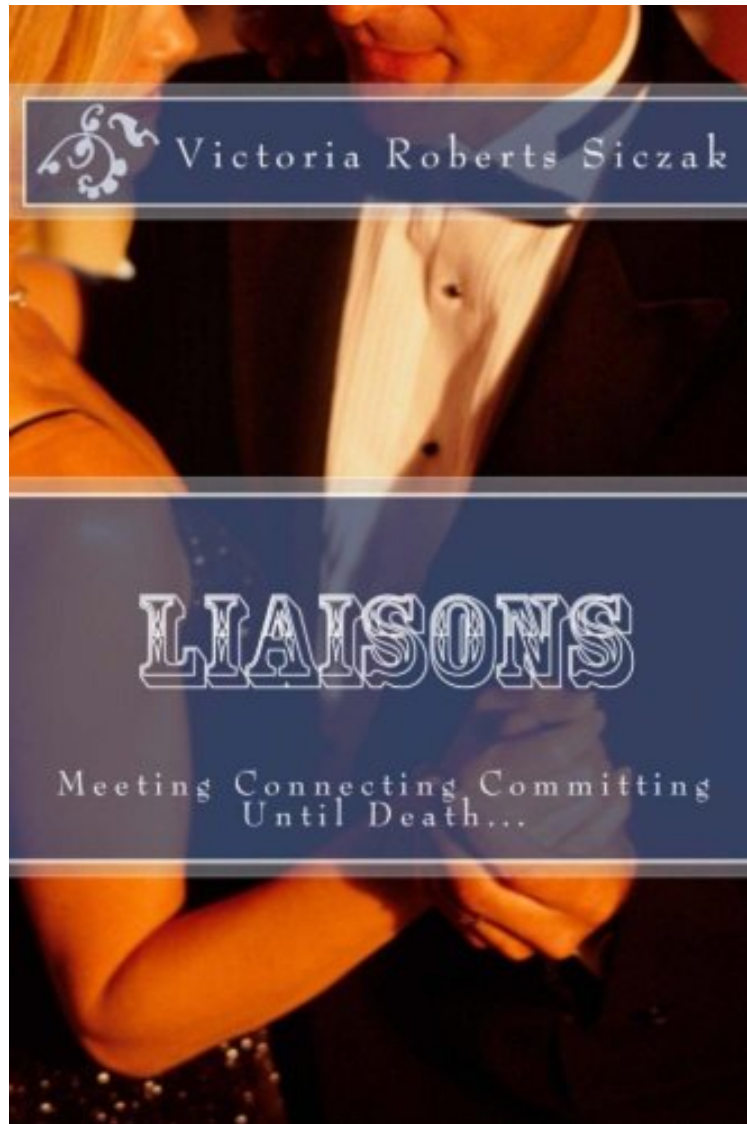

When you're young, thoughts of an ideal partner are pleasant daydreams as you try to imagine what will make you happy. As you grow older and Mr. or Mrs. Right fail to appear, your thoughts might turn a little frantic...and that's when you might rush a choice. The characters in "Liaisons" seemed to me to be a little desperate to find love. I've seen this in real life, where somebody you know and like (a co-worker perhaps) is by themselves for a long time, only to get into a rushed romance and marry all in a whirlwind. The intoxication of a new, or a first, romance can fool people into making some bad choices. Relationships are tough, they're all about compromise and accepting other people's faults as well as your own. When a person is desperate to be in a romance, they find themselves giving up too much of themselves for too little in return. In the book, LIAISONS is a dating service that matches up people with some sort of disorder. The first LIAISONS profile we meet is a man who has a bit of OCD and is compulsively neat. Sure, that doesn't sound like a major flaw...but that's a good set up for people who have quirks that make them difficult or impossible to be in a relationship with. At the same time that I was interested in this book, I was a little saddened by it. I guess I'm fortunate to be in a relationship and to have loving children. I've been married for 6 years, and what I've learned is that perception of the "quirks" disappear. In the first couple years your blind to them, but inevitably things crop up that make you have to work at the marriage. But those things are good because sooner or later you have to recognize you have as much to work on as you perceive your partner has. I think it would be very difficult to go into a marriage with the initial thought that the other person had a "flaw." Sure, you could get away with it for a year or two...but a marriage doesn't get real until about year 4 or 5. Anyway, this story really got me thinking and that's the hallmark of good writing. I think this book is a pretty solid example of romance traps that are best avoided.
