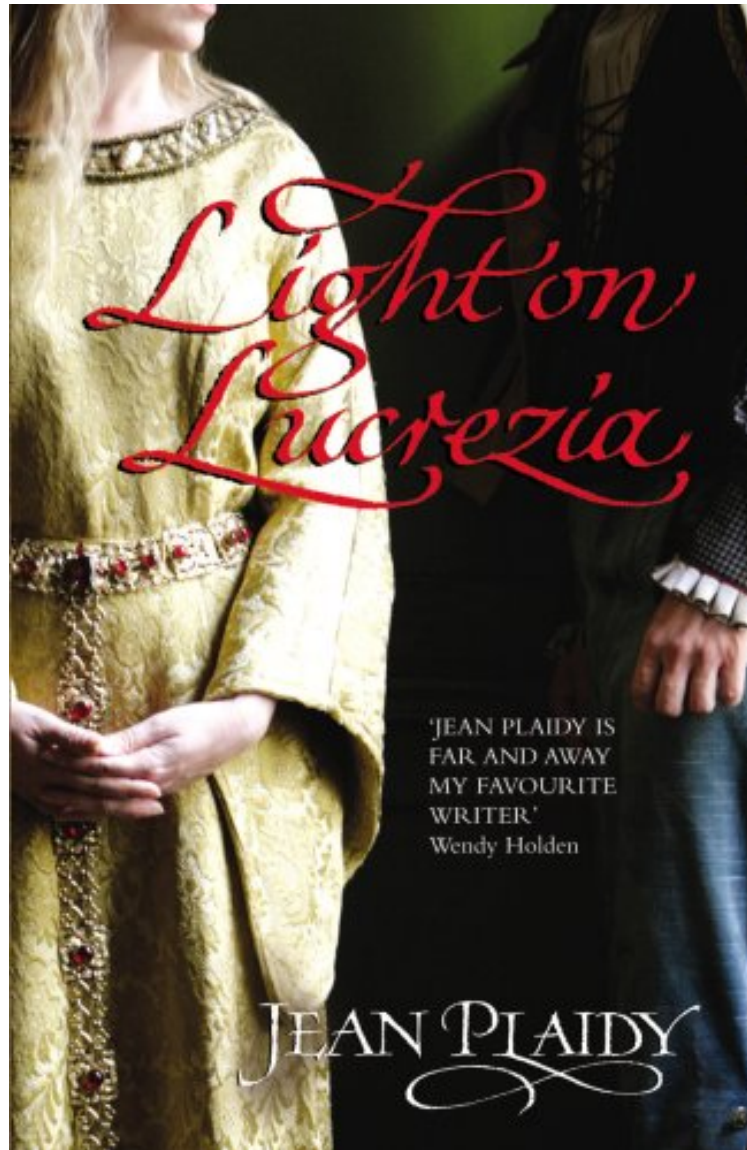

Pope Alexander will draw his illegitimate daughter and her three brothers into a world of richness and scandals that ranged from Pope's affairs with adolescent girls to her brother Cesare's jealousy of anyone who will be near Lucrezia that would result in her conceiving a child in secret... This sequel starts with Lucrezia second marriage although she is just eighteen, when she hoped that all problems are behind her and expects happiness with her new husband, Alfonso. Unfortunately brutal murder will happen and Lucrezia will be torn between love for husband and devotion to her brother Cesare. Those days Borgias ruled the Europe, meaning the almost whole modern world, therefore no one is safe enough of their revenge if something wrong is done, even Lucrezia who is part of the family... "Light on Lucrezia" brings more light to Dark Age of Italian society when Borgias ruled pious and civilian lives. It's strong recommendation to read it together with previously published work "Madonna of the Seven Hills" to be able to learn about all the events from her birth to the day when she married her second husband which is the start of this novel. Her life being the sad story, Lucrezia wasn't able to be happy through all her life due to someone who would destroy even the slightest chance of it. Particularly that could be said about her brother Cesare but there were some others who were equally ruthless. The author succeeded to picture her life in realistic manner filling in the gaps of historical data with her rich imagination. The novel is mainly made in historical, rather than the tabloid writing style, enabling reader to learn not only about rumors and romance stories but also on political issues and reason why Lucrezia did particular things. The novel can be easily read, although sometimes fails to hold the reader's attention enough that may cause loss of interest if you not read it regularly.
