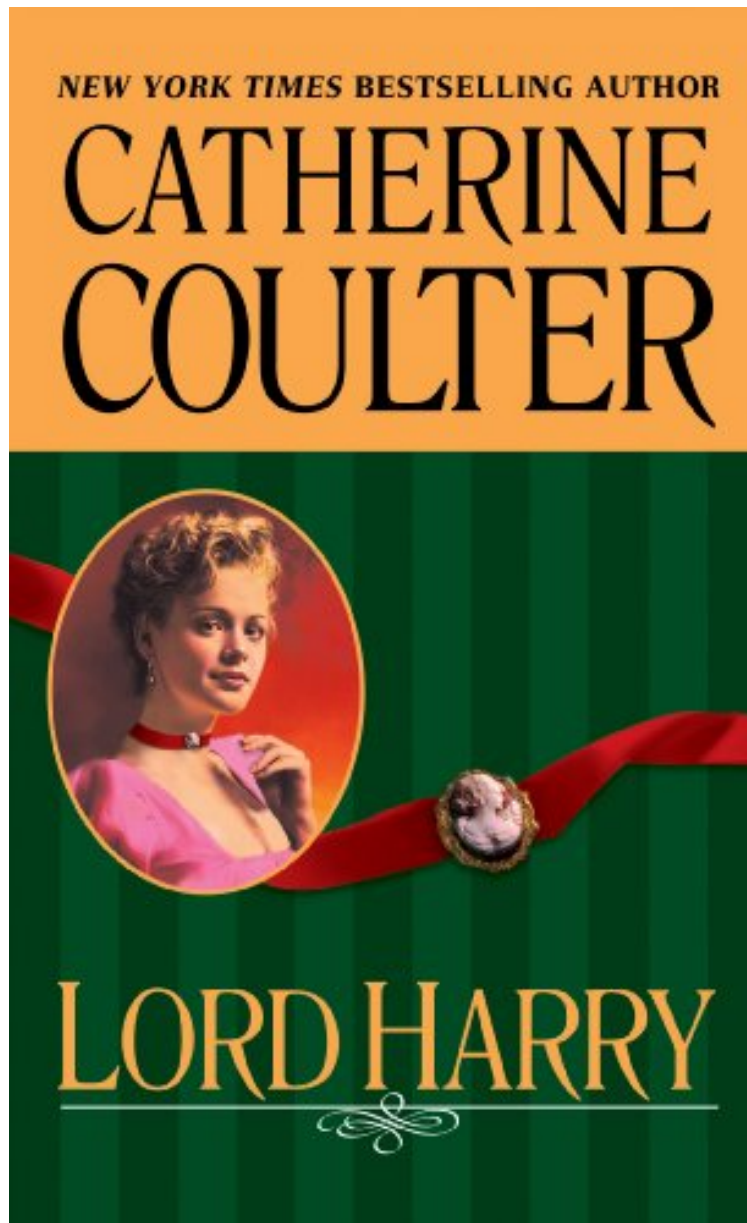

It has a good plot and interesting characters, but the love story is too short - they don't even have sex. I really liked the hero and the heroine. I have to criticise though, that the love the heroine felt towards the hero was not as good portrayed as the love the hero felt towards the heroine. Furthermore that one of the villains of the story wasn't punished, although there was no cause to leave him unpunished (he is a mean person, but when he doesn't bother the protagonists anymore they simply let him continue with his mean behavior towards other persons), so eventually there was no punished villain. That was a bit unsatisfactory. Additionally there is no real ending: Several subplots like another loving relationship between two persons (or not - who knows) have been left unfinished. The heroine acted as a man for months, but no one ever got suspicious. Also no one of the supporting characters asks how the hero and heroine found each other or fell in love. The mistress of the hero didn't do anything when the hero dumped her (did he even do that? - one doesn't know). She just wasn't mentioned anymore. The story has a good plot and is written good, but I think too much is missing. It could be a really great book, if those points were added, so it's disappointing that this is a second edition (second time the author wrote it, not second time it was published).
