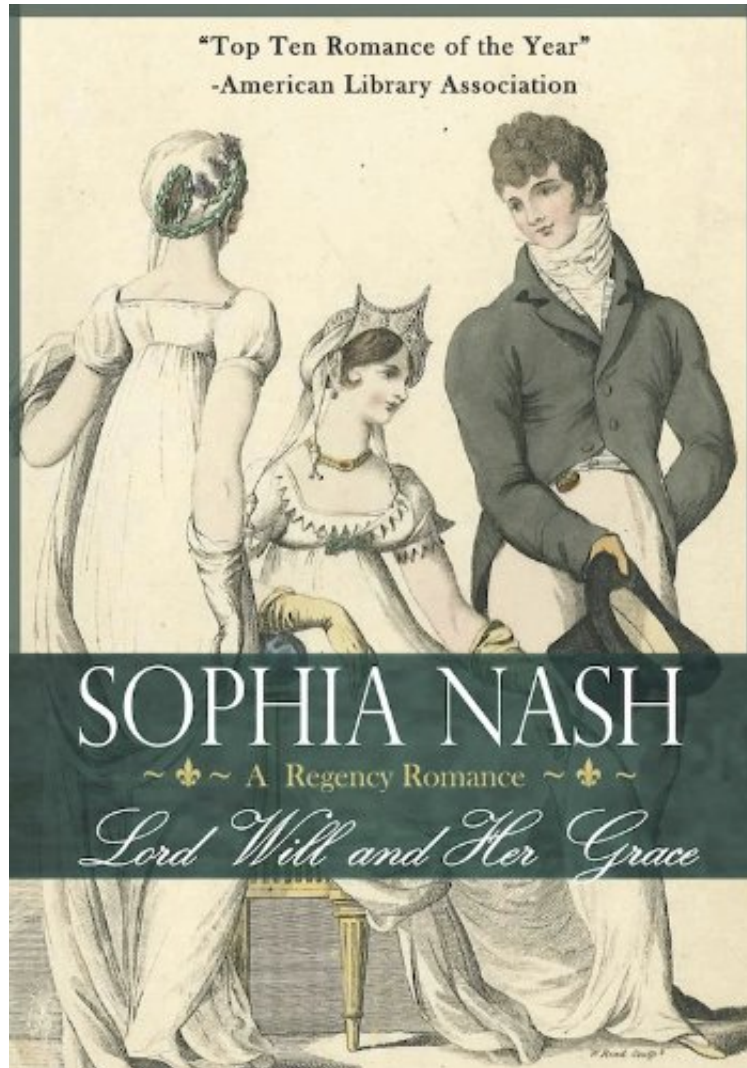

Since she grew up as a vicar's daughter, the title and wealth would be nice; however, if she can't find true love in time Sophie would not really miss it. Fortune hunters have been after her, but she has no interest in them. Her behavior at the Season's balls has placed her in the gossip columns almost daily. Having enough, Sophia retires to Burnham-by-the-Sea, a small seaside village. Lord William "Will" Barclay is the younger son of a marquis. Instead of the maid he finds the daughter of the house in his bed. To escape this trap his valet helps him to flee to his friend. In a little village nearby he meets Sophie by chance. At the age of 29, Sophie is in need of a husband to inherit a fortune and a duchy before her 30th birthday. Therefore she is haunted by noxious fortune hunters who try to bully her into marriage. As a vicar's daughter she isn't very familiar with the viciousness of the Ton. But when she too is caught in a compromising situation she defies the expectations of the Ton to restore her reputation and leaves London. Sophie's first encounter with the destitute but arrogant Lord Will is embarrassing, although she feels attracted to him. Amused and also in need of a fortune, he develops a plan. Knowing her situation, he offers to help her to attract an eligible parti by altering her attitude and behavior. In return, she teaches him character, distaste for dandies and the error of his rakish ways to find a female he would like to marry. This agreement is followed by several clandestine meetings. He shows her the arts of flirtatious coquette for example by using a fan for communication. He continuously oversteps the boundaries of propriety using her sweet naivety and innocent trust. She feels secure, thinking him attracted to men. Fallen in love, she eventually discovers his deception and returns to London heartbroken, to practise her new skills. Even though he had vowed to never again let a woman touch his heart, her innocent conduct provokes emotions he hadn't thought he possessed anymore. Mistrusting him, he has to do great efforts to regain Sophie's attention. But at the precise moment he publicly confesses his feelings, he again is captured. They try to force him to do the honorable thing, that is marry the girl he is accused of having seduced. This destroys all of Sophie's hopes of a happy ending with William. At the wedding of her cousin and his best friend, Sophie expects a final meeting with Lord Will. In his stead, his brother appears and delivers his message, rather incoherently. Not yet recovered from her heartbreak, Sophie refuses to acknowledge Will's message; instead, she clearly utters her opinion. Furious, he breaks his brother's confidence and confesses something of Will's past. Suddenly all details fit well together but under the impression of his marriage to the aforementioned ruined girl, she is unable to take back her decision never to meet him again. At first I thought this plot an enchanting idea, but going on reading I found this bold behavior of Sophie not possible in regency time, regardless of her desperate situation. Therefore only 3.5 stars. But if you can put this thought aside you will rather enjoy the story.
