The plot is crystal clear. The conflict, both internal and external, has been planted firmly in my mind. And I'm relating to the story immediately. Although I'm now over half a century old, I do remember what it's like to score a touchdown. It is a thrill that makes you irresistible, attractive beyond the boundaries of reason. So you go with it, knowing it's your moment, your 15 seconds of fame, and you owe it all to the game.
