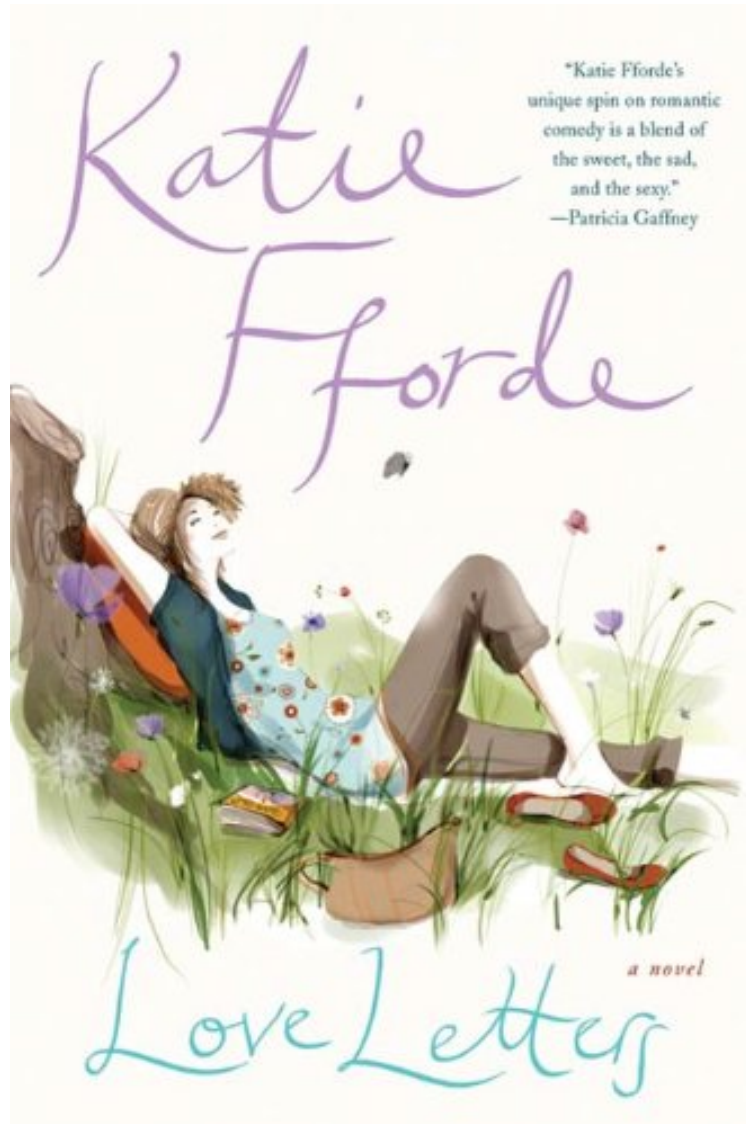

to do with her life, boring dialogues, a plot that never really takes off even though it is about what Ms Fforde should know about - the world of writing romances, not with an eye for quality, but for the sole purpose of making money.
