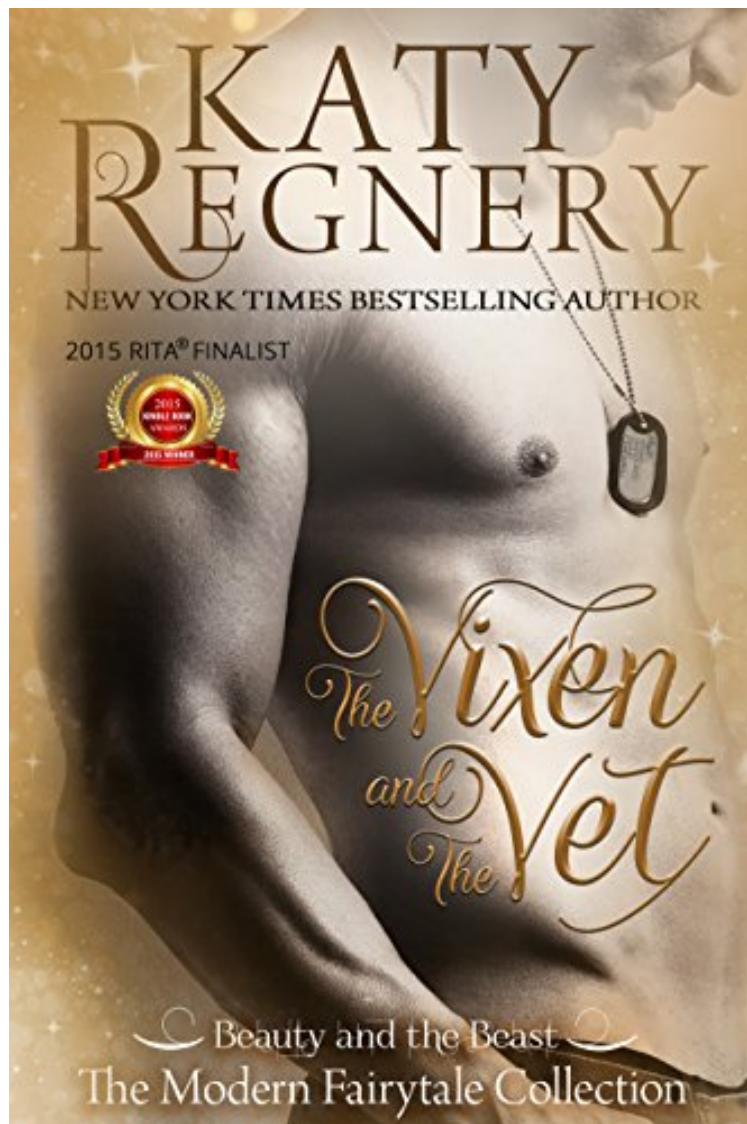

I thought that the relationship between Asher and Savannah developed way too fast, which made the story very unrealistic and I never felt any real chemistry between the protagonists. They fell in love so fast, that I couldn't relate to their feelings or understand why they fell in love. I liked Asher, he was very cute, but I had mixed feelings concerning Savannah. She was nice, but without edges that made her feel human, and I didn't like or understand some of her decisions. Why did it make such a big difference in their relationship if they had sex with or without penetration, especially since she changed her opinion very fast! And I wouldn't say that they had safe sex. Just being on the pill and her asking him if he is safe isn't enough. I mean, she couldn't be safe if she always trusts men she meets a few weeks ago... but that's just my opinion. It didn't bother me that much, but for me this sets a wrong example. Additionally I thought the story lacked depth. In comparison to "Making Faces" by Amy Harmon which was about a similar situation/hero (except that "Making Faces" was a New Adult novel with younger characters and a clean read) this story was just too much on the surface, it never evoked real emotions in me. Asher never really struggled with his emotions or his past, Savannah fell in love without any real struggle and they didn't really have to overcome obstacles, which led to the story being kind of dull. I think story-wise this would've been better as a novella, the story simply lacked substance for a full length novel. BUT it was a very sweet and VERY romantic novel, maybe even too sweet for some readers. I love sweet romances and I found it to be too much in some scenes, Asher never really felt like a real human man, more like a fairytale-prince. So overall I enjoyed reading "The Vixen and The Vet", but it's not a story that will stay in my memory for a longer time.
