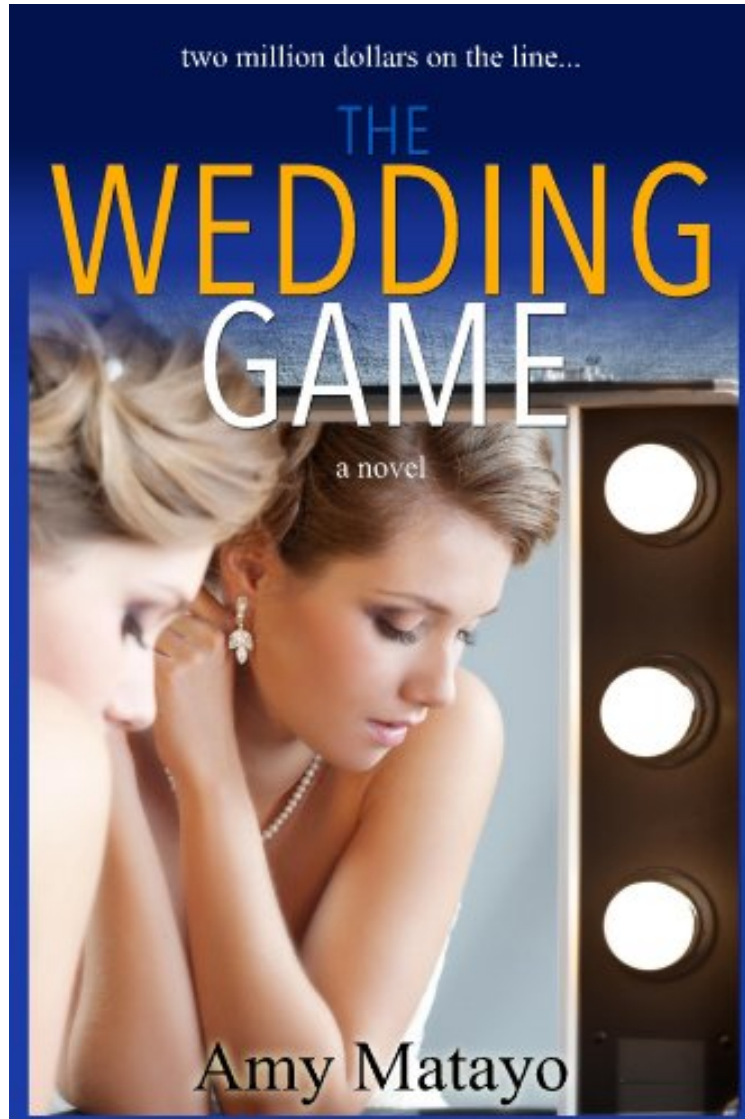

Eine Stärke von Amy Matayo sind witzige, spritzige Dialoge. Einen Punkt Abzug gebe ich, weil manchmal wichtige Ereignisse nur durch danach stattfindende Unterhaltungen wiedergegeben werden.
