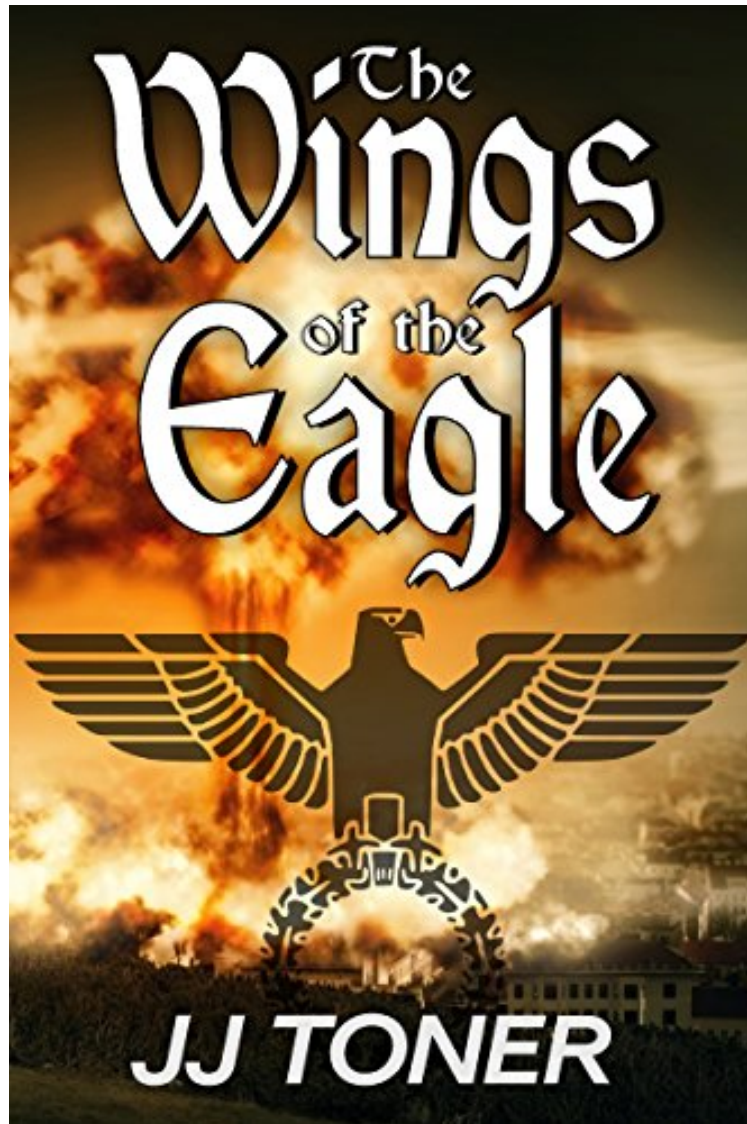

Wings of the Eagle (JJ Toner) Von Sylvia Kreutz Nachdem ich bereits The Black Orchestra gelesen hatte, war ich gespannt auf die Fortsetzung und wurde nicht enttäuscht. Dieses Mal wird Kurt Miller von den Briten nach Deutschland geschickt, um eine Agentin zu befreien und die deutschen Atomversuche während des 2. Weltkriegs auszuspionieren. Sein Weg führt von Haigerloch in Süddeutschland über Leipzig, Berlin nach Regensburg. Dort kommt es schließlich zum ersten großen Showdown zwischen Deutschen, Briten und auch Amerikanern. Über Schweden geht es zurück nach London, wo diese Mission dann endlich abgeschlossen wird. Die Geschichte nimmt sehr schnell an Fahrt auf und es fällt schwer sich loszureißen. Ich habe es mal wieder geschafft einen Roman innerhalb von nur wenigen Stunden in mich aufzusaugen. Fiktion und Realität fließen gut ineinander über. Dabei gibt es allerdings einen Abstrich für die Zeit, in der die Geschichte spielt. JJ Toner lässt Kurt im April 1943 über Süddeutschland abspringen, also im Endeffekt bereits vor der Inbetriebnahme des Forschungsreaktors in Haigerloch. Dennoch kann ich den Spionageroman nur weiterempfehlen. Um einige Passagen besser verstehen zu können, sollte man aber The Black Orchestra bereits gelesen haben. Der Schluss des Romans ist für mich ebenfalls sehr vielversprechend, da Kurt bereits zu seiner nächsten Mission gerufen wird. :-)
