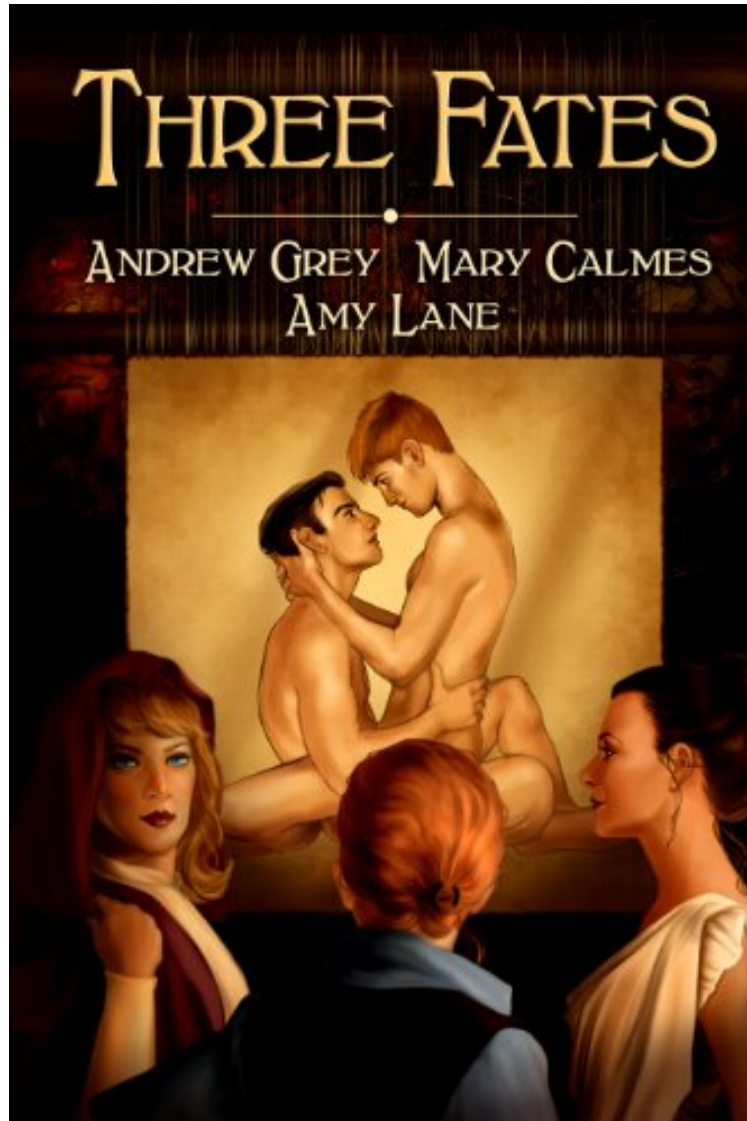

Chey is whiny and constantly complaining that his mate (mine!) is human, he is full of self-pity because of his skin disease (and really! Why won't the author research a bit? Chey uses his cream sometimes if it is really bad, but not regularly or daily. Way to ignore a skin disease!) and his own "ugliness" (= red and irritated skin).

Arthur finds him - of course! - really pretty. Chey is also extremely superficial and really dumb. Arthur, the human prince and Chey's mate, is the only character who is remotely intelligent. A stupid misunderstanding (and really, what do you expect from a guy whose favorite talk is a dramatic monologue and stomping out of the room afterwards?!) is the dramatic climax - solved by others, because the MCs aren't able to talk and solve their problems. Arthur would be luckier without an idiot like Chey, but Fate decides to punish him and so they have to stick together. The characters are superficial, dumb and annoying - the story as well. Jump: 4 stars This is a nice fairytale (but would be a really bad romance). Cass is a nice guy who has one best friend, the best assistant in the world and no more friends (why? I don't know, cause he is funny, loveable, not shy ... maybe he works too much to have friends, but I think he can't have any friends (strings), because he must follow for his love). He and Raza are bewitched to fall instantly in love, so after knowing each other 24 hours Cass decides to follow Raza to Phoenix, leaving town and his job, but taking his assistant with him. His best friend is abroad in Asia, his mother lives somewhere else, so it is easy to take all important persons with him and start new. The characters are loveable and funny, the story nice (in spite of some logical flaws like: after all his life being a seer, the first time the future Cass "saw" changes before coming true while Raza is in danger - what about all the times in his childhood? It is highly inconceivable that something he "saw" in the morning wouldn't change) and though the MCs notice that falling in love after a day and starting life as a couple is really fast, they feel that Fate designed them to be together. A really nice fairytale. Believed You Were Lucky: 3 stars The story is nice enough but could have been shorter (the redundant and boring parts could be erased). Leif and Hacon (Hake) are nice and good for each other. While Leif is unable to get his life in order (and his messed up apartment, as well), Hake is reasonable and a successful businessman. Leif dreams to go to school and become a teacher (and why he wouldn't isn't really understandable - maybe he is waiting for someone to push him a bit in the right direction). While Hake's family is cursed, Leif is a golden lucky boy. He is funny and optimistic and can bring a bit of happiness in Hake's life. The interludes with the Fates and Gods are funny in the beginning, but too much later on. The story is nice but obviously only the mean for Leif and Hake to get to know each other. The fights are unnecessary and stupid, but the Fates prevent any drama and solve all problems. The story is okay, but not for fans of this author, who would expect better.
