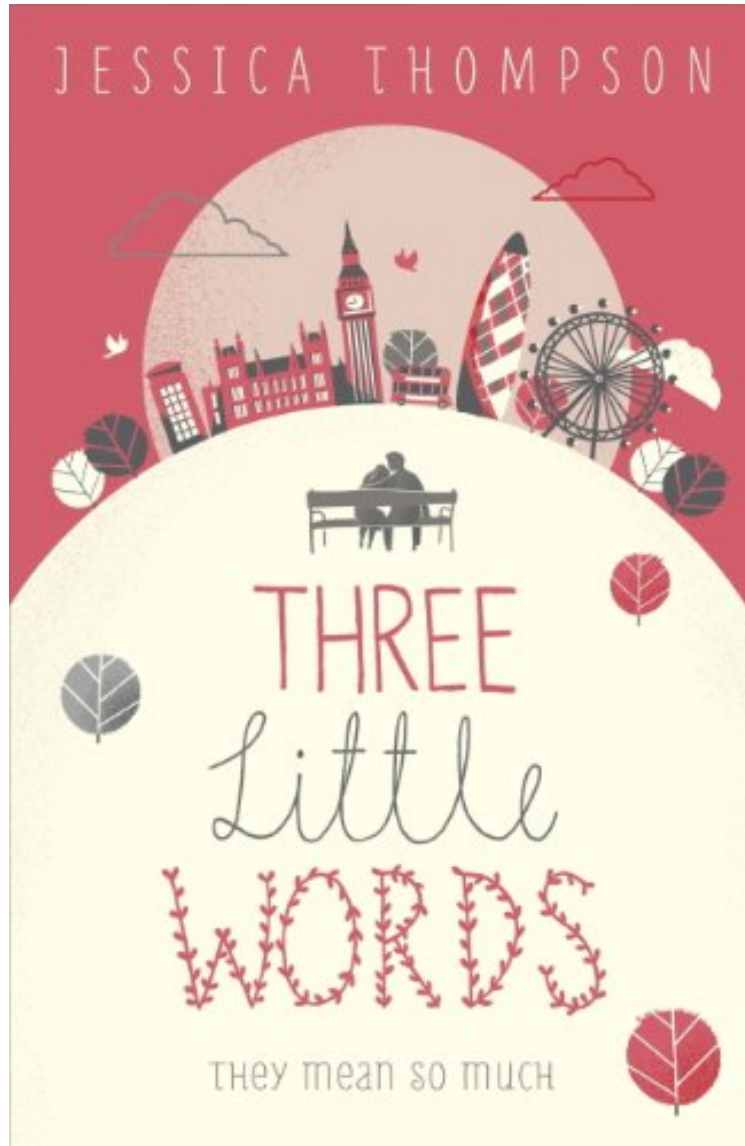

All this happens on the 12th of April 2009. In the course of the book describes Thompson how the persons deal with the stirring events. At that she changes again and again the perspective, which makes the reader recognize the whole drama. Thompson's language is cool and modern, like a constantly circling whirlwind she captures us: makes us laugh, urges the tears in our eyes, lets us shout from despair, shake our head from disbelief and bleed from pain. And this, although a big part of her story is based on stereotypes from movie and television. Maybe it's exactly that what makes the dam of tension and feeling flushes break. Moreover I like the cover very well, as well as the title. Only behind them the book reveals a totally unexpected world with surprising actions to the reader. The cover and title convey a ease, like it is also to find in the novel, but with a heavy and deep ground. The style with the definition of forgive and the quote from Pope is also a wonderful idea and refers to the core of the novel: Learning to pardon and being able to forgive. The interesting thing at the novel is that it is action packed and gentle, heavy and light, sad and funny, profound and shallow at the same time.
