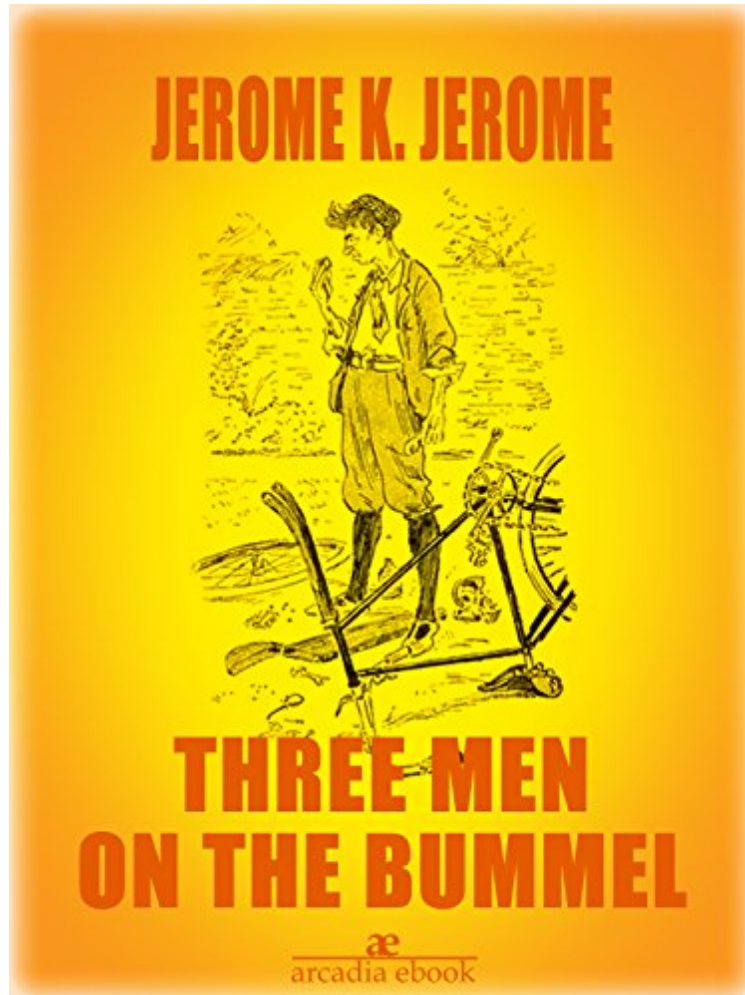

Jeromes first book Three Men in a Boat has been called the most harmless book ever written and as far as harmlessness is concerned the sequel isnt far behind (apart from the ominous last chapter on the Germans blind obedience to authority), yet it lacks the freshness and innocence of its predecessor. Three Men in a Boat was truly original, charming, gentle, atmospheric and funny in a very sweet way and though in Three Men on the Bummel Jerome tries to follow the same recipe he does it less successfully. The book is very slow to take off and while there still are several amusing episodes, others seem a bit contrived and too drawn-out, and last but not least : where is Montmorency, the lovable mutt ???
