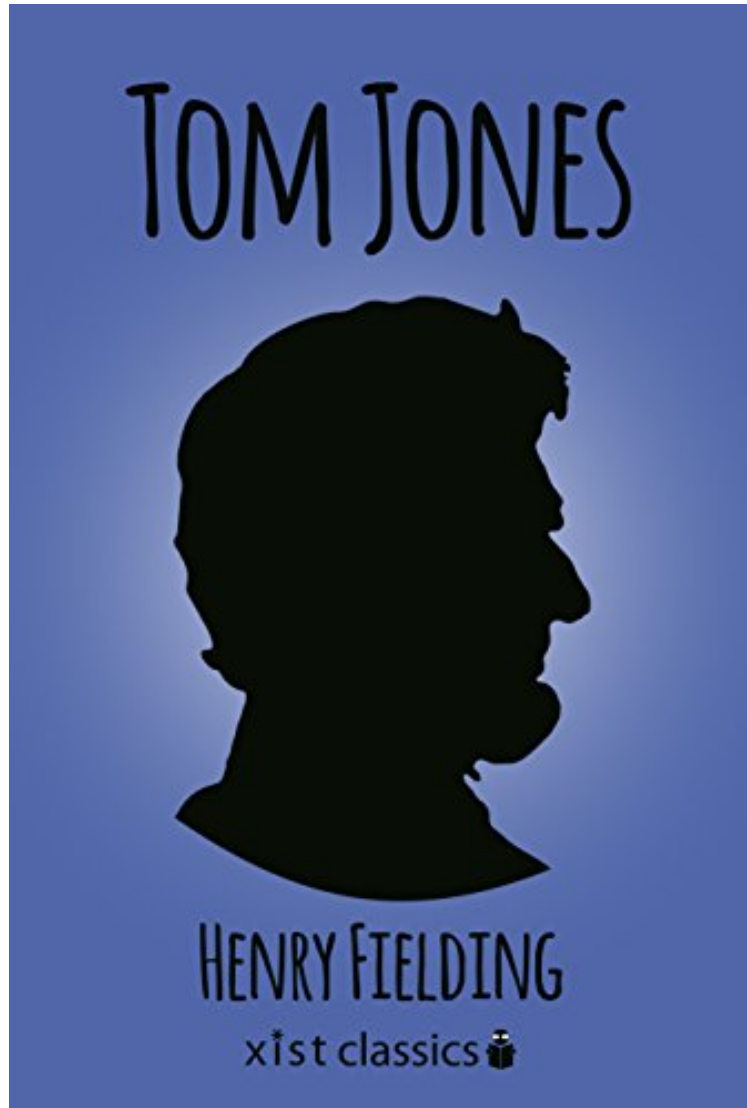

The images are wonderfully portrayed. The main character Tom has many dimensions. He is a rogue, a bumbler, and a womanizer. But at the same time he is heroic, brave, and honorable. Mr. Allworthy is memorable as the virtuous guardian of Tom. Sophia is memorable as a

woman with a mind of her own. One of the greatest things about this book is that even though it is over 800 pages long, it is NEVER boring. We are either in suspense, feeling pity, feeling sorrow, or trying to control our laughter. This was the 3rd book I read in History of the Novel. While I did not like the first 2 at all, I REALLY liked this one. It is interesting that Charles Dickens mentions this book in his "David Copperfield" (1850). If you like this book, you MUST see the movie where Albert Finney plays Tom.

Fielding provides a convincing argument as to the relative importance of chastity and piety as virtues by offering one character (Jones) who possesses every Christian virtue except chastity and piety, against another (Blifil) who has virtually no real virtue except chastity and piety. The moral lesson alone would not make this the greatest novel of all time. Fielding's relaxed, dry, humorous, and affectionate style is the main attraction. Do not try to rush through this book. Be grateful for the time you spend reading it, and go slowly.

An dieser Stellen eine Inhaltsangabe des Romans zu geben, ist schwerlich möglich, da die Handlung aus unzähligen Episoden besteht. Im Zentrum der Handlung steht der herzengute Waisenjunge Tom Jones, der auf dem Anwesen des ebenso edlen Squire Allworthy aufwächst. Seine Schwäche für weibliche Geschlechter bringt Tom jedoch immer wieder in die Bredouille. Auf Grund einer Intrige des eifersüchtigen Blifils, wird er von Allworthy verstoßen und begibt sich im Anschluss auf eine ereignisreiche Wanderschaft durch das England des 18. Jahrhunderts. Ziel all seiner Wünsche ist das Herz der tugendhaften Sophia. Doch bis zum Happy End müssen alle Beteiligten noch unzählige Abenteuer, Verwirrungen und Intrigen überstehen. Fielding zündet ein wahres Feuerwerk an Sprachwitz und herrlicher Situationskomik. Doch enthält der Roman auch eine nicht zu überlesene didaktische Komponente. Tom verkörpert das Ideal eines humanistischen Menschen, trotz aller Probleme, die er sich wegen seiner Liebschaften immer wieder einhandelt. Dagegen zeigt der Erzähler wenig Gnade für intrigante Charaktere wie Blifil oder die heuchlerischen Erzieher Square und Thwackum, deren Verhalten gnadenlos angeprangert wird. Fazit: Immer noch ein herrliches Lesevergnügen. "Tom Jones" gehört mit zu den unterhaltsamsten Romanen des 18. Jahrhunderts.
